NOTICE OF HEARING

The State of Nevada, Department of Business and Industry, Office of the Labor Commissioner, hereby notifies all interested parties that a hearing pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) section 338.030 will be held on April 19, 2022. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain information concerning objections filed relating to the Prevailing Wage Rate and/or Job Classification/Job Description for Fence Erector in Clark County/Southern Nevada Rural Region.

NRS section 338.030 states in relevant part:

2. The prevailing wage in each such region must be determined by the Labor Commissioner. To determine the prevailing wage in each region, the Labor Commissioner shall, in each odd-numbered year, survey contractors who have performed work in the region. Within 30 days after the determination is issued:

(a) A public body or person entitled under subsection 5 to be heard may submit an objection to the Labor Commissioner with evidence to substantiate that a different wage prevails; and

(b) Any person may submit information to the Labor Commissioner that would support a change in the prevailing wage of a craft or type of work by 50 cents or more per hour in any region.

3. The Labor Commissioner shall hold a hearing in the region in which the work is to be executed if the Labor Commissioner:

(a) Is in doubt as to the prevailing wage; or

(b) Receives an objection or information pursuant to subsection 2.

The Labor Commissioner may hold only one hearing a year on the prevailing wage of any craft or type of work in any region.

4. Notice of the hearing must be advertised in a newspaper in the region in which the work is to be executed once a week for 2 weeks before the time of the hearing.

1 5. At the hearing, any public body, the crafts affiliated with the State
2 Federation of Labor or other recognized national labor organizations, and the
3 contractors of the region or their representatives must be heard. From the evidence
4 presented, the Labor Commissioner shall determine the prevailing wage.

5 **SUBMITTING WRITTEN STATEMENTS AND/OR EVIDENCE** The parties, and the parties
6 identified in subdivision 5 of NRS section 338.030, may submit written statements/positions and any
7 other information and/or evidence in writing to the Office of the Labor Commissioner on or before
8 **April 11, 2022.** This can be submitted electronically to mail1@labor.nv.gov.
