## **APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY**

The Painters, Glaziers, and Floor Coverers Joint Apprenticeship Committee will be accepting applications for the purpose of establishing a pool of eligible candidates. Applications will be accepted Monday through Friday from March 5, 2018 through April 6, 2018 between the hours of 8am to 10am and 1pm to 3pm each day. All applicants must meet the following requirements, no exceptions:

- 1. Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- 2. Must possess either a High School Diploma, G.E.D., or High School Equivalency
- **3.** Must be physically capable of performing the essential functions of the trade without posing a direct threat to the health and safety of the themselves or any other individuals within reasonable accommodations
- 4. Must participate in a basic math evaluation for ranking purposes
- 5. Must be able to appear before the JATC Board for an oral interview
- 6. Must be able to pass a drug screen urinalysis upon acceptance into one the programs

## The following documents must be provided at the time of application:

- 1. Proof of date of birth birth certificate
- 2. High School Diploma, G.E.D. Certificate, or High School Equivalency
- 3. Valid government issued ID
- 4. Military Release Papers DD-214 (if applicable)
- 5. Proof of previous trade experience (if applicable)
