### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK OF THE TRADE

**Plasterer** – Using tools of the trade, a Plasterer may apply plaster, veneers, acrylic finishes, stucco, fire proofing, or other polymer-based or cementitious products to walls, beams, columns, or panels.

**Cement Mason** – Using tools of the trade, a Cement Mason may form, smooth, and finish freshly placed concrete or cementitious products; make repairs to existing concrete surfaces; may also color, stain, sandblast, stamp, expose, and seal concrete or cementitious products.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. **AGE:** Not less than 17 years of age as of the date of application.
2. **EDUCATION:** High School Graduate/GED, or equivalent is not required but highly desirable.
3. **PHYSICAL:** Must be capable of performing the essential functions of the trade with or without reasonable accommodations.
4. **LANGUAGE:** Should have an understanding and ability in reading, writing, and communicating in the English language.
5. **ELIGIBILITY:** Must be legally eligible to work in the United States and have sufficient legal documentation to complete an I-9 form.
6. **TESTS:** Must possess the natural aptitudes essential to acquiring the skills of the trade, as determined by prescribed aptitude tests. **Must pass a drug test** prior to acceptance into the program.
7. **INTERVIEW:** An oral interview will be given.

### ALL APPLICANTS MUST HAVE WITH THEM THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS TO COMPLETE AN APPLICATION

1. Provide copy of proof of date of birth – Birth Certificate or Valid ID-Driver's License.
2. Provide copy of High School Diploma/High School Equivalency. Must provide an Official transcript(s) for high school and post high school education and training.
3. Provide copy of Military Discharge DD-214, if a veteran.
