Only completed applications with copies of the three required documents listed below will be accepted. Legible copies of the following documents must be included with the application, or the application will be considered incomplete and rejected:

Applicants Must:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Take a New Entrant Exam.
- Participate in an oral interview.

At time of selection, Applicants:

- Must pass a drug test
- Perform the work of the trade with reasonable accommodations.
- Must be able to lift, carry, push, or pull 100 lbs. Should be able to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, reach and feel.
