Announcement of Future Apprenticeship Opportunities: Accepting Applications

Southern Nevada Laborers Local # 872 Training Trust will be accepting applications for: Apprentice Construction Craft Laborer

Apprenticeship applications will be available for pickup at our office beginning May 5, 2025, through June 10, 2025. Our office is located at 1750 E. Sahara Ave, Las Vegas, NV 89104. Applications can be picked up during our regular business hours; Monday – Friday, 7am - 4:30pm, we are closed 12pm-1pm for lunch. Applications will also be available online at www.local872.com/applynow. Online applications must be downloaded and printed. Completed Apprentice Construction Craft Laborer applications will only be accepted in person on Wednesday, June 11, 2025. Applications are accepted between the hours of 8am - 3pm, we are closed from 12pm-1pm for lunch. Only completed applications with copies of the three required documents listed below will be accepted. Legible copies of the following documents must be included with the application, or the application will be considered incomplete and rejected:

- ❖ Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport
- ❖ Copy of Valid U.S. picture ID
- ❖ Copy of High School Diploma or equivalent

Applicants Must:

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Take a New Entrant Exam.
- Participate in an oral interview.

At the time of selection, Applicants:

- Must pass a drug test
- Must be able to perform the work of the trade with reasonable accommodations.
- Must be able to lift, carry, push, or pull 100 lbs. Should be able to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, reach, and feel.
- Must have a basic understanding of how to read, write, and communicate in the English language.

The recruitment, selection, employment, and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex. The sponsor will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in the apprenticeship program and will operate the apprenticeship program as required in Title 29 of the code of Federal Regulations, Part 30, and equal opportunity regulations of the State of Nevada.
