**WHEREAS**, more than 5,000 active registered apprentices in Nevada are currently training in high-skill careers that will provide opportunity for achievement as well as contribute to the overall prosperity of our state; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Nevada applauds all those working to better our workforce with the positive impact that apprenticeships have on individuals, their families and our business community;
