
Dear Mr. Williams,

I would like to request that our apprenticeship program, Stationary Engineers Local 39 remain active and not be deregistered. We have been actively accepting applications every other year, giving our apprentice exam and establishing an active list for dispatching apprentice candidates. I did dispatch to the Grand Sierra Hotel and a candidate was offered an apprenticeship but turned it down due to insufficient pay prior to COVID.

We were going to go through the process of accepting applications in May of 2020 establishing a new list of candidates to dispatch. Due to the COVID shelter in place, we were not able to proceed with the test, complying to our local ordinances for the health and safety of the public. We are hopeful to indenture an apprentice into our program. Our application date is scheduled for May 16, 2022 with anticipation of having an apprentice this upcoming cycle. We would like the opportunity to achieve this in light of everything that has happened due to the global pandemic.
